I. STAGE: WHY YOU SHOULD BECOME A WIKIPEDIA CONTRIBUTOR

Step 1 good reasons to be involved in Wikipedia

There are many good reasons to be involved in Wikipedia:

- It's educational.
- It's social.
- It's interesting to share your knowledge with other people, particularly knowing that others can instantly edit or react to what you've written.
- It helps others.
- Learning to write in a neutral point of view is a useful intellectual exercise, since it requires cultivating humility and respect for the views of others.
- Wikipedia is a remarkable phenomenon of social organization; learning how things work here provides valuable lessons for many other kinds of organizations.

II STAGE. THE WAY OF GETTING REGISTERED

Step 1 and 2 : Go to Wikipedia and Click "Create Account"

Step 1: Go to Google Chrome, Firefox Mozilla, Internet Explorer or any web browser and enter

https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Main_Page

Step 2: Click 'Create Account' on the top right corner of the screen and fill out the few required fields. This will be logged, your account will be created, and you will be provided with a link back to this page.

Step 3: Click "Create your Account"

User Name: name that represents you as the individual person. Case sensitive, first letter is always capitalized, you do not need to use all uppercase. Note that this need not be your real name.
 Password: Enter the password that is easy to remember. Confirm password: Confirm by re-entering the password.
 Email address: The account creator must have Email ID before creating a Wikipedia Account. Enter the existing Email ID.
 We need this to send you your password. Without it, you will not receive your password, and will be unable to log in to your account. Comments: Please do NOT ask for a specific password. One will be randomly created.
 Enter the text mentioned in the box: Type the letters that appear in the box. If it is unclear to you then, click 'Refresh'.
 Check your e-mail inbox for updates and further instructions regarding your account request.

Step 4 : Registered user in Wikipedia

After clicking on 'Create your Account', you will receive a notification from Wiki that you are now a registered user in Wikipedia.

- Only Wikipedia users (Account holder) can do the following things:
- Rename or move a page. Here, you can give an existing page another name. For this to happen, click the 'Move' tab at the top, enter the new name and then click 'Move Page'.
 - Change semi-protected pages. You can protect pages from being changed only if your account is at least four days old and have made at least ten changes.
 - Send and receive e-mails from other users. This is optional.
 - Edit personal settings on their own accounts.
 - Set a watchlist to see changes made to articles by other users.
 - Create a personal user page where they can write about themselves, add userboxes and a personal talk page for discussing with other users.
 - Get permissions to undo vandalism made by the last user (rollback), to review user's access to different tasks on Wikipedia (reviewer) and to use tools to effectively run Wikipedia (admin).
 - Check all their changes made using the "My changes" link.

Wikipedia not only allows you to create, revise, and edit articles. Collaborative editing means that incomplete or poorly written first drafts can evolve over time into excellent articles.

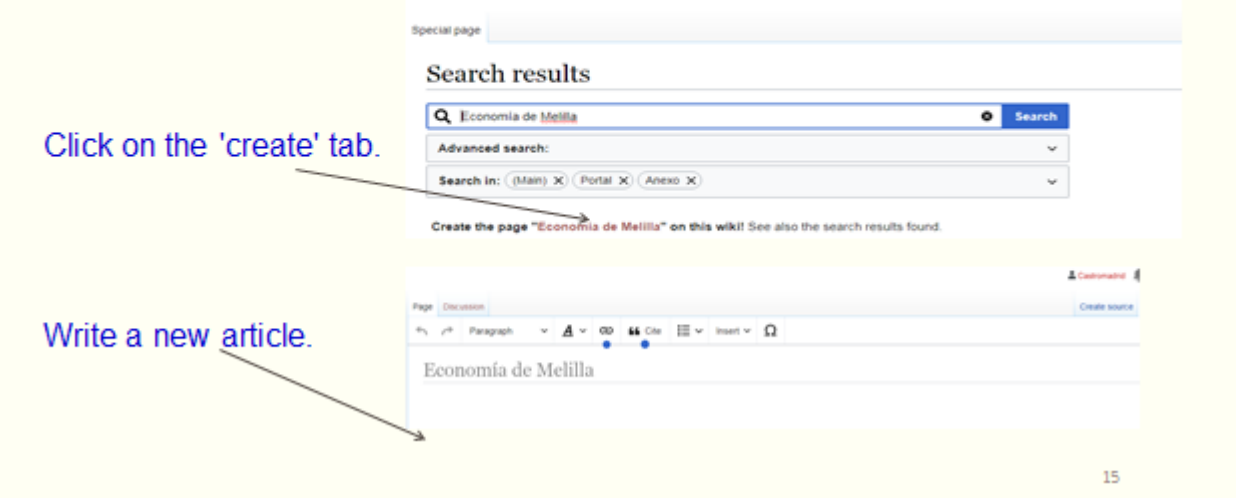

Wikipedia requires that information be verifiable in reliable external sources. Ideally, all information should refer to reliable outside sources, using citations.

When adding content and creating new articles, an encyclopedic style with a formal tone is important. Instead of essay-like, argumentative, or opinionated writing, Wikipedia articles should have a straightforward, just-the-facts style.

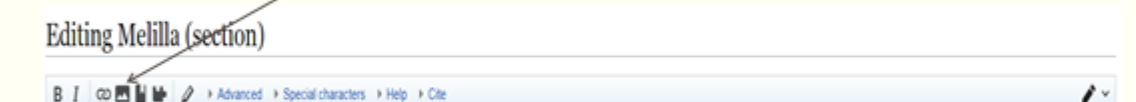
Step 6. New article

Find page in user space.

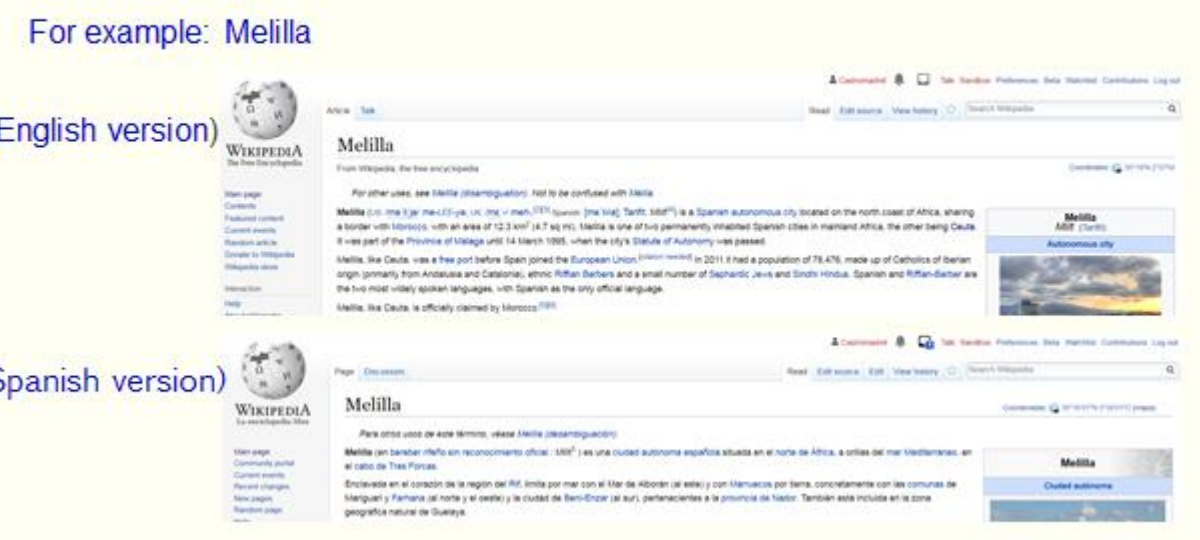


Step 7 Add a photo

An encyclopedia is not complete without pictures but you must provide detailed information on the source and the license of the file

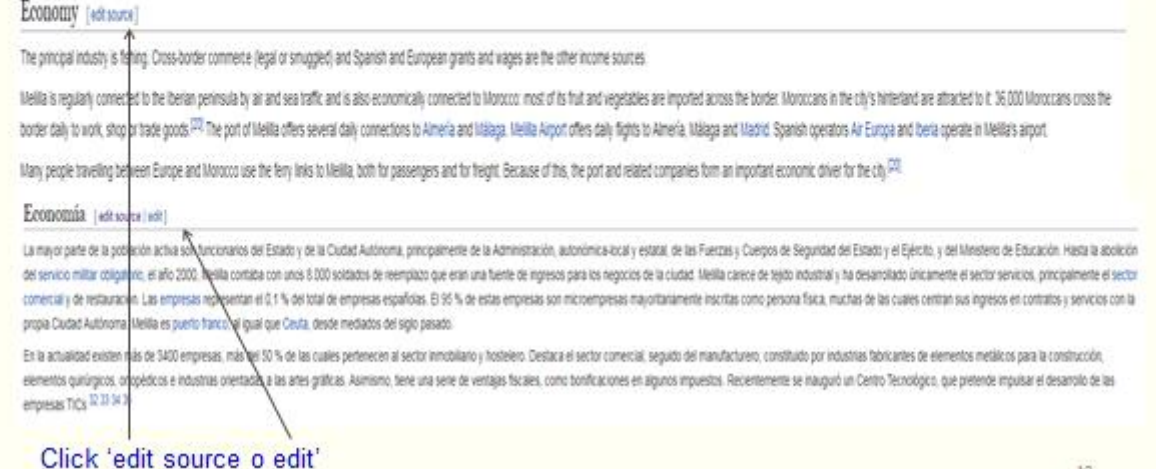


Step 3. Page where you want to collaborate

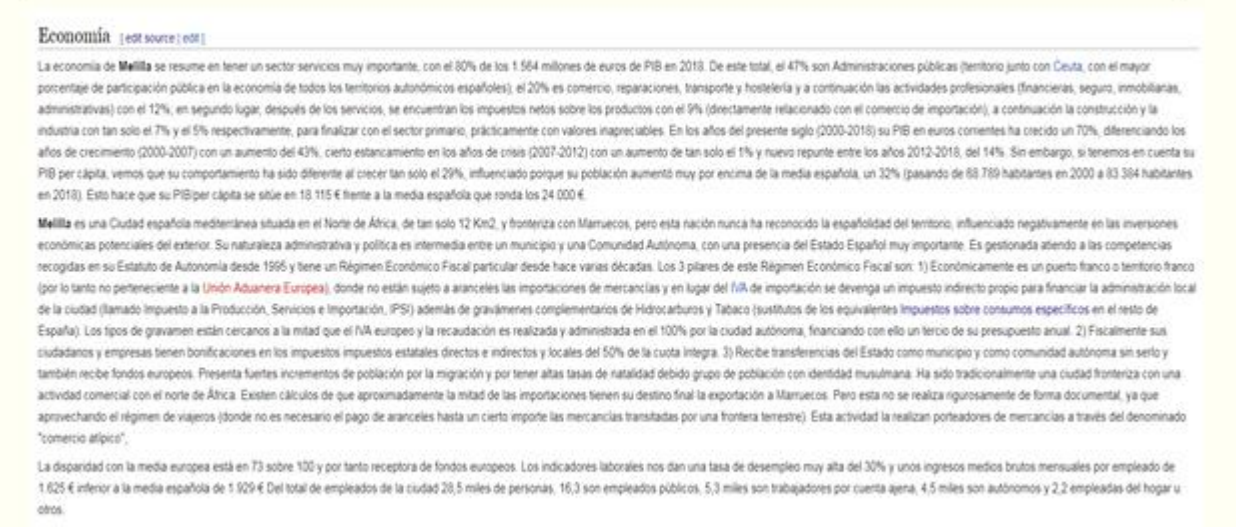
Step 5. Write corrections on the text and Publish changes
