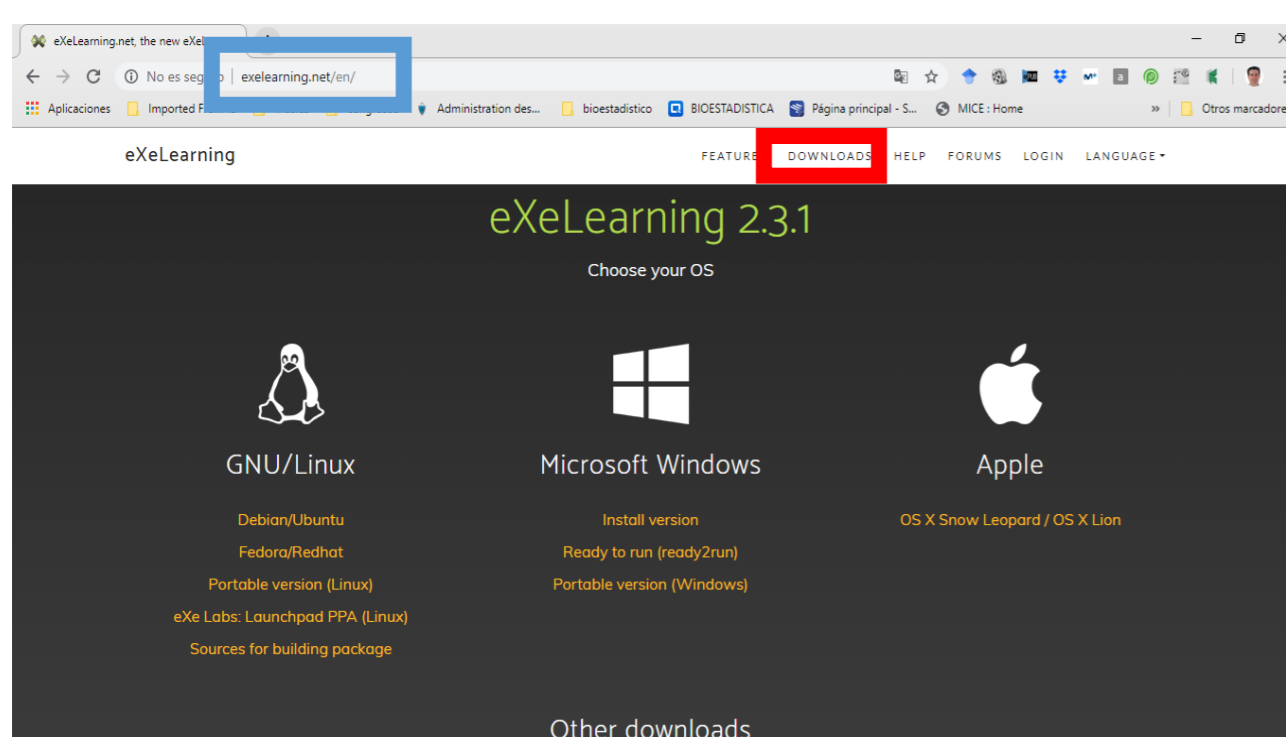

DESCRIPTION

- eXeLearning is a free / libre software tool under GPL-2 that can be used to create educational interactive web content.
- eXeLearning can generate interactive contents in XHTML or HTML5 format. It allows you to create easily navigable web pages including text, images, interactive activities, image galleries or multimedia clips.
- eXeLearning, available for Linux, Microsoft Windows and Mac OS X,[3] allows you to create or develop accessible contents in XHTML or HTML5 format, to generate complete websites (navigable web pages), to include interactive contents (different types of questions and activities) in each page, to export the contents in different formats such as ePub3 (an open standard for e-books), IMS or SCORM (educational standards used to publish interactive contents in platforms or elearning tools as Moodle or any other OER (Open Educational Resources) repositories or XLIFF (standard for translation).

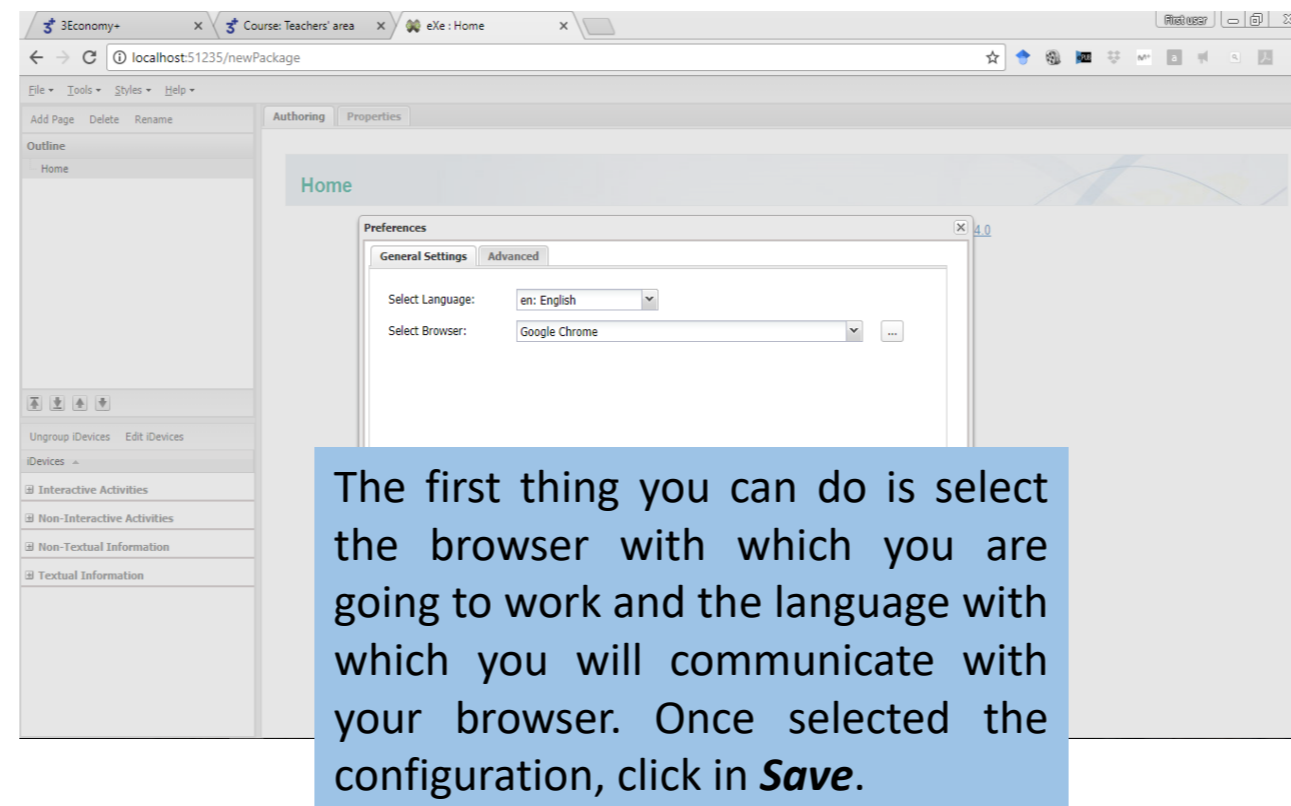

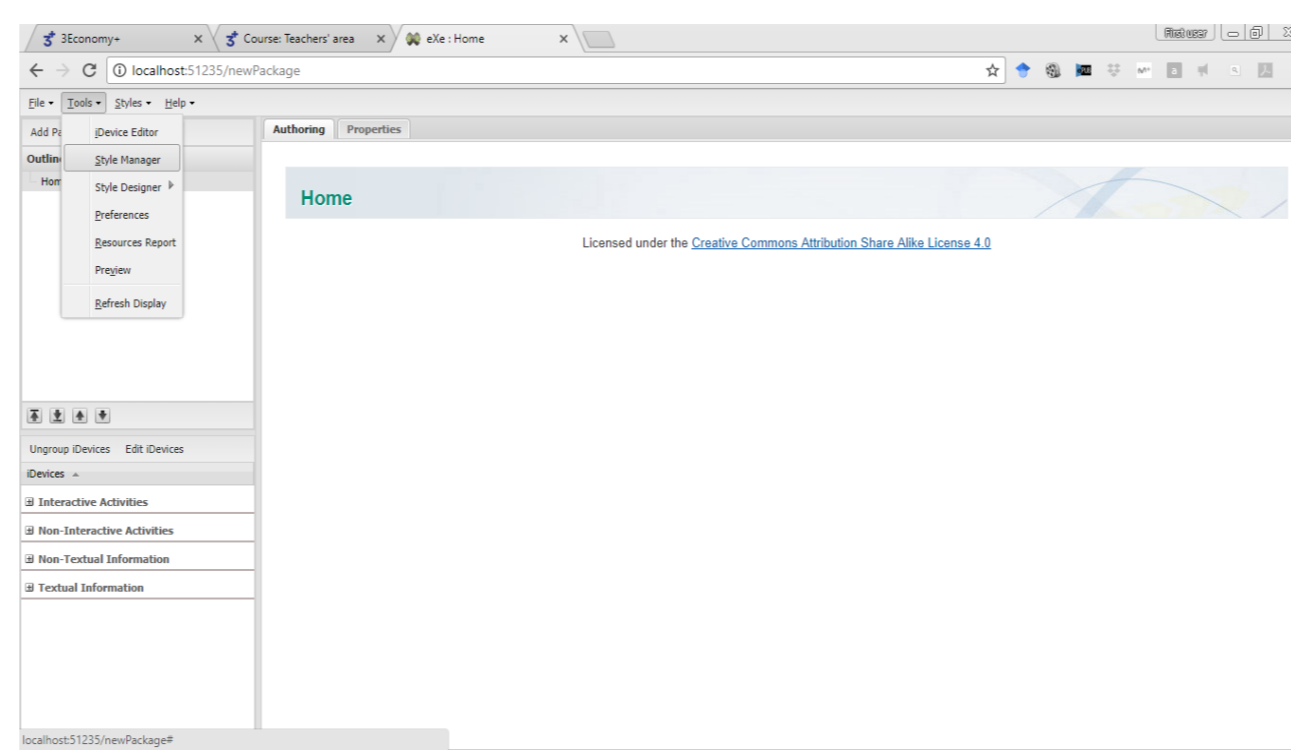


FIRST STEPS

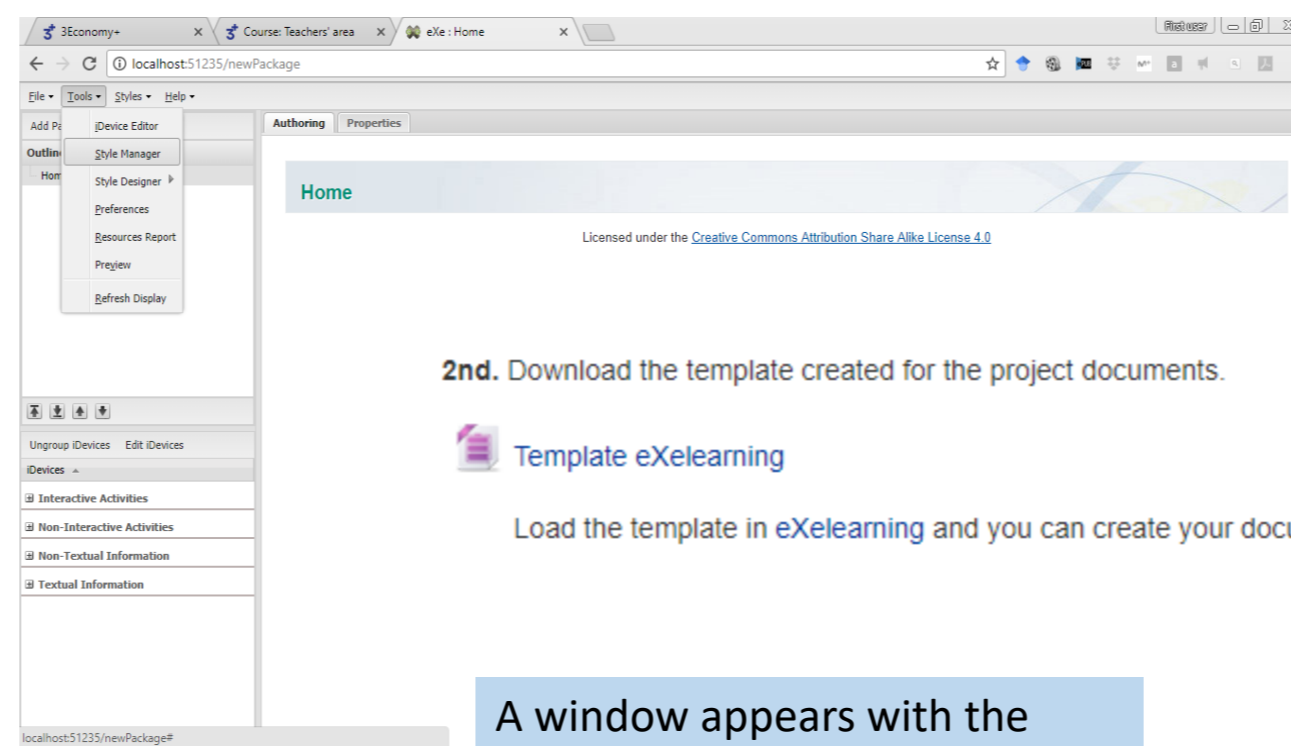
1st Start eXeLearning



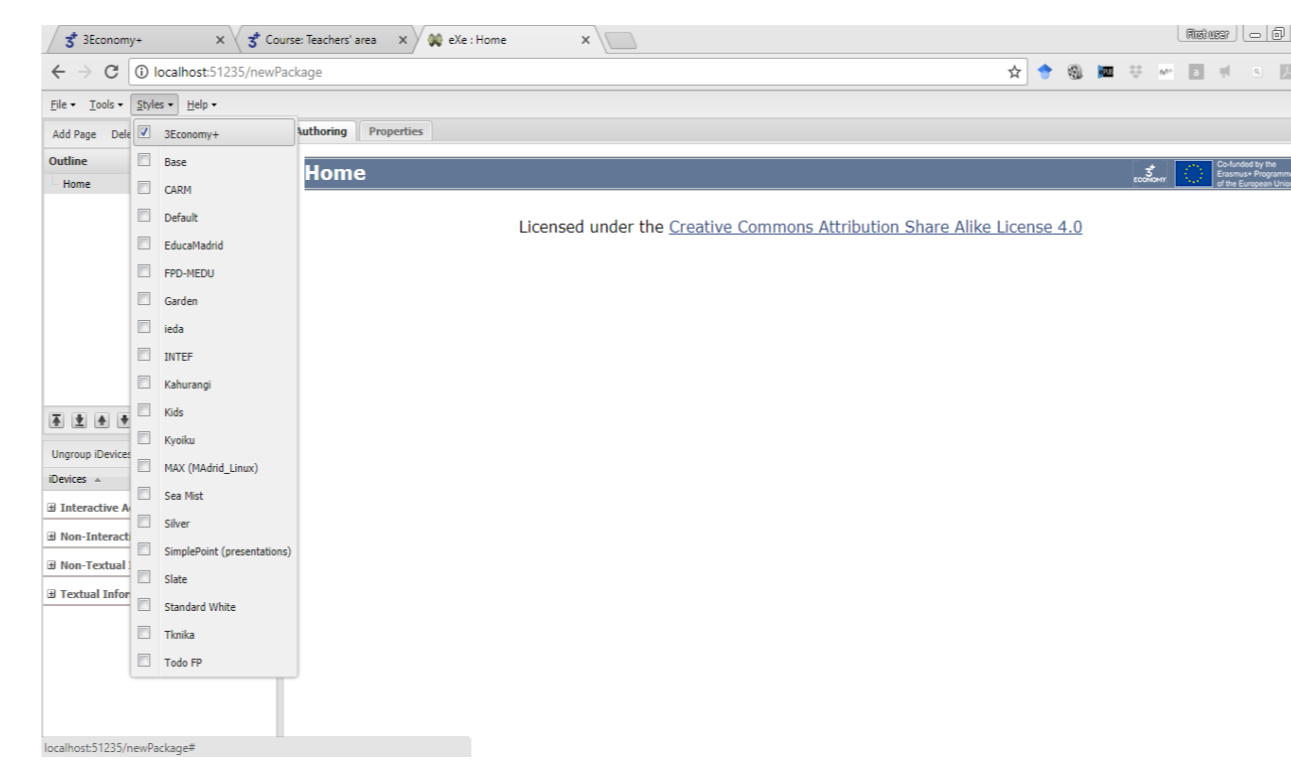
2nd Upload our stylesheet. To do this, we select in the menu Tools and then Style Manager



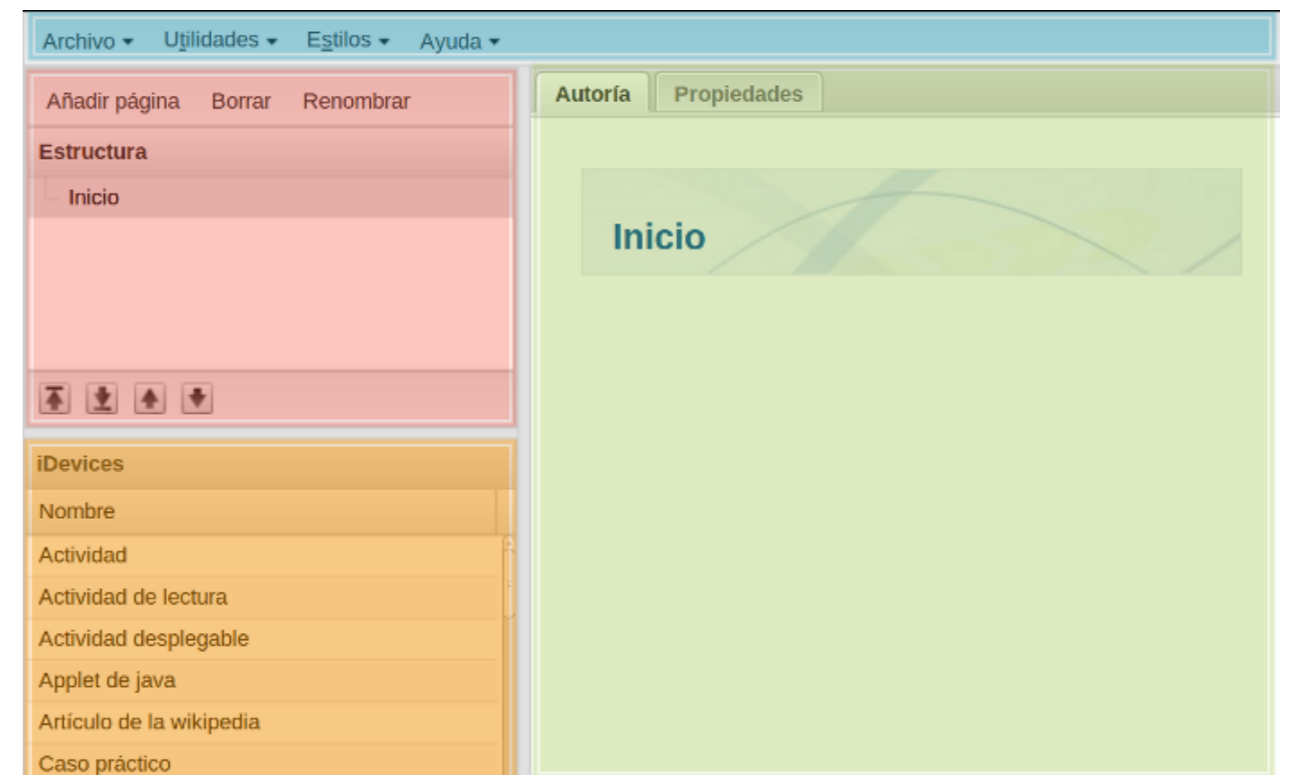
3rd Install our template. You can download it from our LMS



4th Once the 3economy+ style is loaded, we can start creating our materials as if it were a Word document

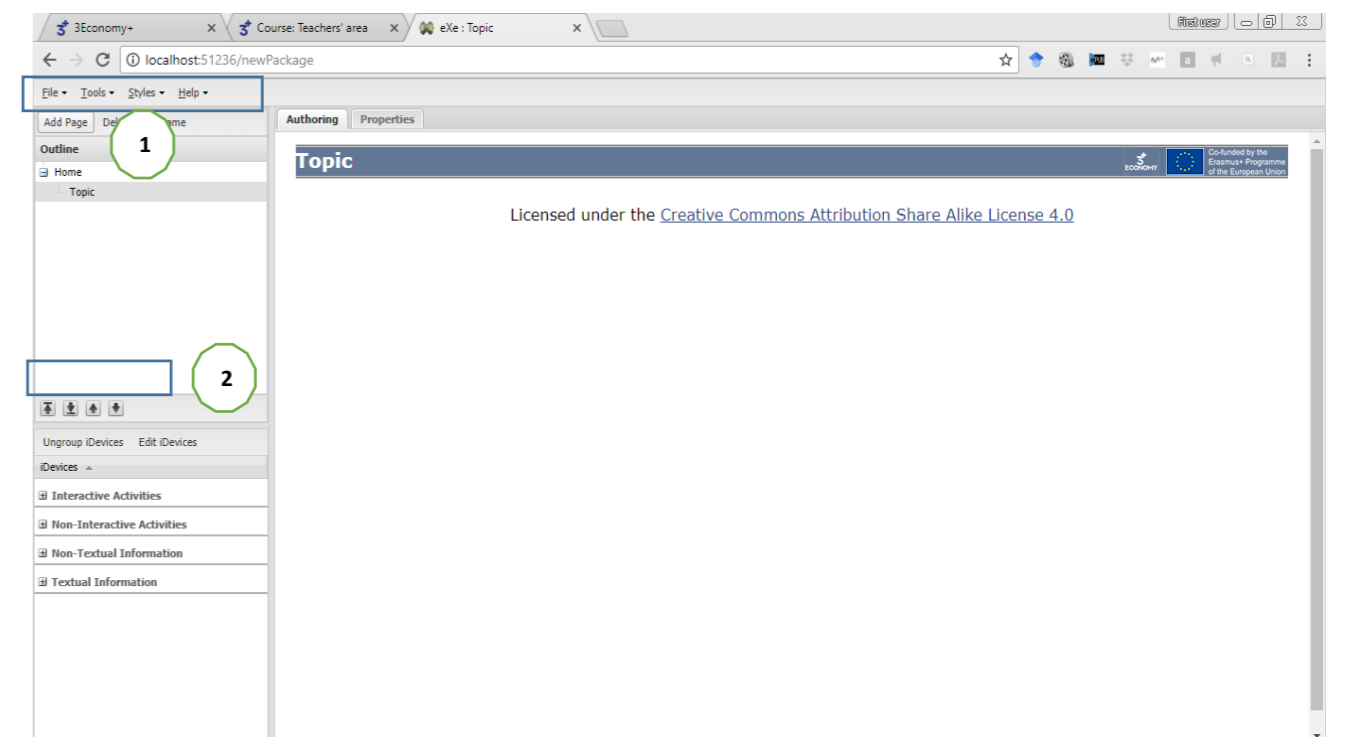


5th When opening eXeLearning we will find four well differentiated areas:

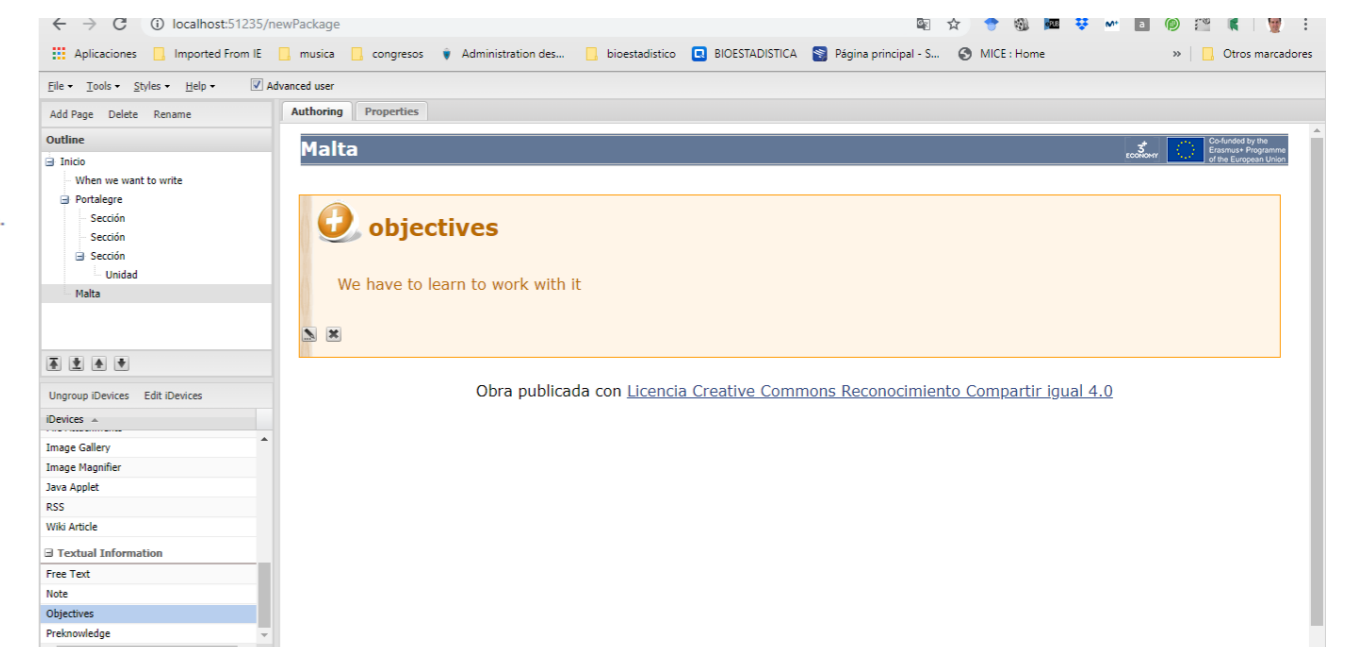


- Structure:** we can create indexes of our contents.
- Main menu:** we can manage files, printing, exports, styles, user preferences and help.
- iDevices:** different activities to include in the generated content.
- Work area:** in the authorship tab we can visualize the created contents and in properties include metadata referring to our creations.

6th Create the structure of the document, creating and giving name to as many pages as our subject has (1). In addition, we can create different levels of pages within the document or change a created page level (2)



7th Create new sheets, change names, write text, etc.



8th To finish, we will see how to save the document that we have created. For this, in the File menu, "Save as" option allows you to save it as an eXeLearning file, which has the extension .elp
